The enclosed candidate form is provided for the following available positions being elected at the NCS USBCA Annual Meeting on May 15, 2021 at the Hawthorne Conference Center, 420 High Street SW, Winston-Salem, NC 27101. The positions up for election this year are:

2020 Positions – All board members agreed to extend their term one (1) year

Vice-President (one position – two-year term remaining)

Directors NCS USBCA #4, #5, #6, #10 (four positions – 2-year term remaining)

Youth Director #12 (one position – one-year term) **vote not needed see below**

Delegates voted for 2020 season will represent NC for 2021 National Convention.

2021 Positions will also be voted upon at this meeting

President – (one position – three-year term)

Directors NCS USBCA #1, #2, #3, #9 (four positions – three-year term)

Youth Director # 12 (one position – one-year term)

Delegates to the 2022 USBC National Convention (two positions & two alternates – one-year term)

All Adult and Youth Delegates vote for all positions.

- The forms for **all** positions have been combined into one composite form. You may apply for more than one position on the application form. Please make sure you mark the correct position(s) for which you wish to be a candidate.
- To be listed on the candidate slate, you must postmark the submitted form no later than **Jan. 11, 2021**. To be nominated from the floor, a candidate's credentials must be submitted 14 days prior to the opening of the annual meeting (**April 30, 2021**).
- To serve on the NCS USBCA Board of Directors, you must be a member of the Registered Volunteer Program or have applied for Registered Volunteer Program status. Proof must be provided within 20 days of 2021 Annual Meeting to our NC USBC Association Manager.
- There will be a "Meet the Candidates" forum on Saturday, May 15, 2020, prior to the elections. All qualified candidates are invited to participate, whether slated on the ballot or running from the floor.

We are looking for candidates who will bring expertise in one or more of the following areas: leadership skills, knowledge of local/state/national bylaws and rules, computer experience, finance experience, organizational skills, ability to resolve problems, dependability, accountability, communications/public speaking/people skills, marketing/promotional experience, confidentiality, and being a part of the NCS USBCA "team".

Potential candidates must be able to prove they support the sport of bowling by actions, and that they will represent the state association and its policies without any personal agenda.

It is a necessity that you are an adult or youth bowler who believes you can provide a **positive** contribution to the NCS USBCA, support its mission and values, and represent the state association in its workings with local associations.
