2. Must have participated in a NC State USBC-approved” qualifying event in at least 15 different years. (Participation as a “touring professional” for a full year is considered a qualifying event).
3. Must have at least one of the following:
 - a. 210 average for 10 years in NC State USBC-approved qualifying events (male candidates)
 - b. 200 average for 10 years in NC State USBC-approved qualifying events (female candidates)
 - c. Top-10 finish in a NC State USBC-approved qualifying event.

Accomplishments in other national, international and other important bowling events will also be considered; however, the Committee may waive those requirements. Example: A waiver by the Committee could granted be for reasons of illness or injury that shortened a player’s career.
